

INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the Department of Corrections, (hereinafter referred to as the DEPARTMENT"), Fiscal Bureau, whose address and phone number are 1539 11th Avenue, Helena, Montana, and (406) 444-3930; and (Department of Public Health & Human Services, Child Enforcement Services Division - CSED), (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR"), whose address, and phone number are , 3075 N. THE DEPARTMENT AND THE CONTRACTOR AS PARTIES TO THIS AGREEMENT, AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES CONTAINED HEREIN, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- F. The verification of existing support orders and payment history on non-IV-E foster care placements by accessing the VRU, and VRI screens only.

The data base information is provided with the understanding that all confidentiality requirements of CSED will be followed by the DEPARTMENT, including those in 45 CFR 303.21.

Additionally, the DEPARTMENT understands that information obtained through the SEARCHS system, other than information concerning the most recent payment and its relationship to disregards, may not be released to any party either orally or in writing. The DEPARTMENT will direct all inquiries concerning IV-D cases to the CSED customer service unit.

The DEPARTMENT will instruct its workers as to the terms of this agreement.

ADDENDUM

This is an addendum to an agreement currently in place between the Child Support Enforcement Division and the Public Assistance Bureau, Child and Family Services Division, dated 12/14/95.

The purpose of this addendum is to allow the Children's Services Bureau, Child and Family Services Division, to access the System for the Enforcement and Recovery of Child Support (SEARCHS), the Child Support Enforcement Division's data base, for the following:

A. The verification of child support payments, household composition, and other pertinent data elements in determining funding sources for IV-E placements.

F B. The verification of existing support orders and payment history on non-IV-E foster care placements by accessing the VRU, and VRI screens only.

B. The determination of medical coverage for Medicaid applicants and participants.

C. The determination of case status and recent actions taken by the Child Support Enforcement Investigators on medicaid and IV-E cases only.

The data base information is provided with the understanding that all confidentiality requirements of CSED will be followed by CFSD-Children's Services Bureau, including those in 45 CFR 303.21.

Additionally, the CFSD - Children's Services Bureau understands that cases may not be viewed for any other purpose than outlined in this agreement.

The CFSD will instruct its workers as to the terms of this addendum and the original agreement. Additionally, the CFSD will provide a photocopy of this agreement and addendum to each Children's Services Bureau worker who is approved for SEARCHS system access.
