Furloughed Offender Missing in Great Falls

The Montana Department of Corrections on Wednesday issued an arrest warrant for Jenny Louise Terrell, an offender on supervised release in Great Falls who could not be located at her residence or possible job site. She faces a charge of escape.

Terrell, 31, was on an extended furlough from the Montana Women's Prison. The state Board of Pardons and Parole approved Terrell for the program, which allows offenders an opportunity to get a job and find a place in preparation for eventual parole. She was furloughed Oct. 9 for 10 days, and received a 10-day extension last week in order to secure employment.

Her parole officer could not locate Terrell on Wednesday.

Terrell was serving a 10-year sentence for a December 2005 escape from the Great Falls Prerelease Center. She had previously been sentenced for a 2000 theft out of Ravalli County.

Terrell is 5' 7" and weighs 150 pounds. She is white and has brown hair and hazel eyes. Her sentence would have expired in March 2009.

Since Jan. 1, the Board of Pardons and Paroles has paroled more than 70 inmates from 10-day furloughs.
